- 3. All vendors and community organizations are expected to be open for business during these hours; No EARLY breakdowns can occur prior to 6:00 pm. Except upon APPROVAL. All areas must be cleaned and vacated by 7:30pm.
- 4. Space will be reserved on a first come, first served basis.
- 5. Occupants are responsible for bringing their own tables, canopy, and chairs.
- 6. If Booth spaces are not cleaned and vacated by 8:00pm on the day of the event, we will have someone assist you and there will be a \$50.00 fee, per helper for their assistance.
- 7. Alcoholic beverages are **NOT** permitted to be **sold** on the streets or within the event area.
- 8. Electricity is **NOT** provided, and **NO** loud generators are permitted.

- 13. There will be NO guns, ammunition, pepper spray, or weapons or any kind sold or present on the grounds.
- 14. All City, County and State regulations will be obeyed.
- 15. Face Masks are Optional.
- 16. Please follow the CDC COVID-19 Guidelines.
- 17. All Pictures will be uplifted on our Social Media.
