JUNETEENTH VENDOR & RESOURCE CONTRACT

Event Policies and Procedures

1. The operating hours for the event are 10:00am to 6:00pm.
2. Set-up will begin at 7:30am and must be completed by 11:30am.
3. All vendors and community organizations are expected to be open for business during these hours; no breakdowns can occur prior to 6:00 pm, unless prior authorization, from Ms. Barbara Howard. All areas must be cleaned and vacated by 7:30pm.
4. Space will be reserved on a first come, first served basis.
5. Occupants are responsible for bringing their own tables, canopy and chairs.
6. Spaces must be cleaned and vacated by 7:30pm on the day of the event or a clean-up fee of \$50.00 per space will be charged.
7. Alcoholic beverages, Cannabis are **not** permitted to be sold or consumed on the streets or within the event area.
8. Electricity is not provided and no loud generators are permitted.
9. Vehicle traffic is not allowed within the event boundaries between 10:00am and 6:00pm – no exceptions.
10. All Vendor water containers **must** be emptied into waste water container on Market and San Pablo Street.
11. All merchandise must remain within vendor booth spaces.
12. The Annual Juneteenth Celebration and Festival is a family event. No merchandise featuring drugs, drug paraphernalia or explicit sexual connotations will be permitted. The Staff reserves the right to remove vendors offering such merchandise for sale.
13. There will be no guns, ammunition, pepper spray, or weapons or any kind sold or present on the grounds.
14. All City, County and State regulations will be obeyed.

I have read and understand the above-listed event policies and procedures.
